This is an application seeking withdrawal of the writ petition, however with liberty to file fresh one on the same cause of action.

It can be seen from the record that no interim order was granted by this court while issuing notice on 21.01.2020. Counsel for the petitioners stated that the parties are in the process of entering into a compromise. However, with a view to ascertain the correctness of his statement, I am of the opinion that permission to withdraw the writ petition, as prayed for, can only be granted after factum of compromise is verified from the private contesting respondents. Therefore, appropriate orders on the application for withdrawal shall be passed only after service on the respondents is affected and they are properly represented in the case.
