ORDER

21.01.2026

1. The petitioner No. 01 is wife of the respondent. The petitioners No. 2 & 3 are minor children borne out of said wedlock of the petitioner No. 01 & the respondent.
2. By a purported Special Lok Adalat Award dated 23.08.2025, the matrimonial related litigation involving the petitioner No. 01 and the respondent was brought to an end on the basis of a purported compromise deed presented before the Bench No. 01 of the Special Lok Adalat.
3. The petitioners are now coming forward with the present petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India to

relieve themselves from said Lok Adalat Award saying that the respondent has acted in breach of the same.

4. Issue notice to the respondent.
5. Petitioner No. 1 to furnish registered postal cover within a period of 07 days whereupon notice shall go to the respondent.
6. Application CM No. 112/2026 is allowed dispensing with filing of certified copy of the lok adalat award for time being.
7. Notice in CM No. 113/2026.
8. List on 23.02.2026.
9. In the meantime, the operation of the lok adalat award dated 23.08.2025 shall remain stayed.
