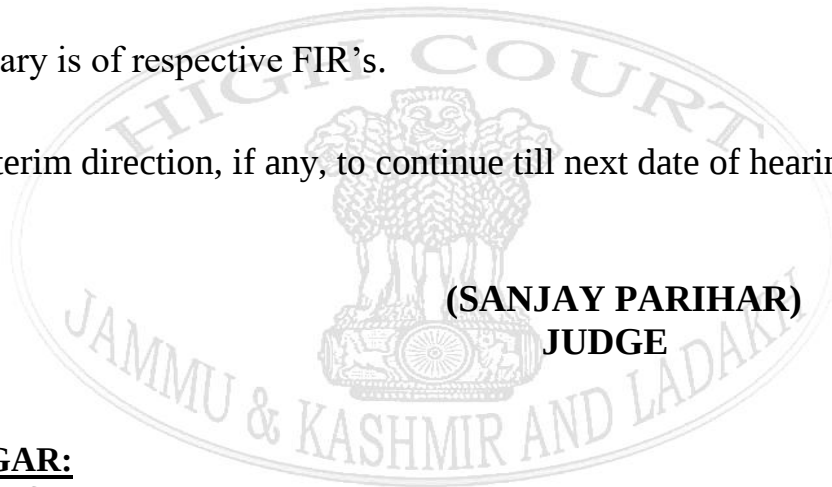

**ORDER
08.05.2026**

1. During the course of hearing, Mr. Z.A. Qureshi, Ld. Sr. counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that despite the clear-cut directions passed by this Court on 25.02.2026 staying the investigation in FIR No. 10/2026 and FIR No. 12/2026 both of P/S Batmaloo, the I.O has proceeded ahead and filed the charge-sheet, so much so, even in the charge-sheet, mention of the order is reflected. Which is controverted by the other side on the premise that in a separate proceeding arising out of CRM(M) No. 151/2026, the coordinate Bench in terms of order dated 03.04.2026, had directed that challan arising out of case FIR No. 12/2026 shall be put to trial along with the charge-sheet reported to have already arisen from case FIR No. 11/2026 and, that in view of the subsequent order, no

illegality has been committed by the I.O in filing charge-sheet arising out of case FIR No. 12/2026.

2. It is further apprised to this Court that along with two petitions there are other connecting petitions as well that may be clubbed together. Ld. counsel for the parties shall furnish the details of the connecting matters.
3. List on 30.05.2026.
4. Meantime, I.O of case FIR No. 09/2026, 10/2026, 11/2026 and 12/2026 of P/S Batmaloo shall appear in person along with Case Diary is of respective FIR's.
5. Interim direction, if any, to continue till next date of hearing.
