ORDER

CrIM No. 473/2026:

For the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed and the requirement of filing certified copy of challan is dispensed with. The petitioner shall file the same within one week.

CrIM disposed of.

CRM (M) No. 190/2026:

The petitioner has, challenged charge sheet emanating from FIR No. 79/2018, for offences under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 of RPC registered with Police Station, Tangmarg which is stated to be pending before the court of Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Tangmarg.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner had assailed the aforesaid FIR by virtue of another petition bearing

CRM (M) No. 325/2022 in which interim direction came to be passed on 18.08.2022 whereby the investigating agency was directed not to file challan without seeking permission of the court. It has been submitted that the said direction is still in force but despite this, respondent No. 1 has filed the impugned challan against the petitioner and in fact, the same has been done in absence of the petitioner. It has been submitted that the learned trial court has issued warrants of arrest against the petitioner.

Issue notice to the respondents. Notice be sent to respondent No. 1 and 2 through Mr. Jahangir Dar, learned GA. Notice be sent to other respondents through concerned Police Station.

In the meantime, the proceedings in the impugned challan pending before the learned trial court shall remain stayed. It is further directed that the warrants issued against the petitioner shall not be executed.
