This is an application filed by the petitioner seeking a direction to the respondents to disburse the compensation deposited by the intending department in favour of the applicant. He seeks release of the same without prejudice to his rights.

Respondents have filed their objections by stating that the amount has been deposited with the Collectorate Office for disbursement.

Mr. Bikram Deep Singh, learned Dy. AG submits that the petitioner can approach the Collector for disbursement of the said amount.

Having regard to the submissions made and the fact that an amount of Rs. 25.00 lacs has been deposited and respondents having no objection in case the amount so deposited is released in favour of the petitioner, therefore the application is allowed.

The amount deposited be released by the Collector concerned in favour of the claimants whenever they approach the concerned Collector.

This order has been passed without the prejudice to the rights of the parties.

The application is disposed of.
