ORDER
03.06.2026

01. By virtue of order dated 05.05.2026, the Registrar Judicial of this Court was directed to verify from the concerned school(s) the certificates placed on record by the petitioners as proof of their age within a period of two weeks, whereupon the Registrar Judicial was to place a note before this Court.

02. In compliance with the aforesaid order, the Registrar Judicial of this Court has placed on record letter dated 13.05.2026 with respect to the verification of the age certificate issued in favour of petitioner No. 2-Seerat Manzoor, wherein the Block Medical Officer, Verinag has submitted that the certificate has not been issued by the said office and the seal and signature on the said certificate do not pertain to the said office.
03. In light of the aforesaid report, the Chief Medical Officer, Anantnag, who happens to be the Chairman of the District Medical Board, Anantnag has relied upon the said communication and submitted a report to the Registrar Judicial of this Court, which has been placed on record.
04. Thus, in the light of the report submitted by the Chief Medical Officer, Anantnag, on the basis of the communication received from the Block Medical Officer, Verinag, the certificate placed on record by petitioner No. 2-SeeratManzoor appears to be fictitious/forged. Consequently, this Court was misled by the petitioners, which led to the passing of the order dated 05.05.2026.
05. However, insofar as the age proof of petitioner No. 1 is concerned, the report has been submitted by the concerned Principal certifying that the certificate issued in his favour is genuine.
06. In the aforesaid backdrop, this Court deems it appropriate to withdraw the protection already granted vide order dated 05.05.2026 and directs the personal presence of petitioner No. 2 before this Court. Accordingly, the interim direction dated 05.05.2026 is vacated.

07. Accordingly, the SHO, Police Station Rajpora, District Pulwama is directed to produce petitioner No. 2- Seerat Manzoor D/O Manzoor Ahmad Mir and R/o Achu Guz Bamnoo, Pulwama, J&K before this Court on 6th June, 2026.

08. Registry is directed to convey this order to the SHO, Police Station Rajpora, District Pulwama for its immediate compliance.
