Petitioner through the medium of this petition claiming to be in the business of street vending activity of fruit chaat selling at Chashma Shahi Gate, falling under the jurisdiction of Municipal Ward No.1, alleged that the respondents along with police have been interfering into his peaceful business. It has been prayed that the official respondents be directed to constitute Town Vending Committees and observe the mandate of "The Street Vendors (Protection of Livelihood and Regulation of Street Vending) Act 2014" and also to direct the respondents not to cause any interference in the peaceful conduct of the street vending activity of fruit chaat selling, carried by the petitioner at Chashma Shahi Gate, Srinagar.

03. Notice to respondents returnable within a period of four weeks.

05. List on **04.07.2026**.

In the meanwhile, the respondents are directed to observe the mandate of “**The Street Vendors (Protection of Livelihood and Regulation of Street Vending) Act 2014**” and if the petitioner is entitled under the Act to carry on his business activity at Chashma Shahi Gate, he be allowed to operate as vendor.
