For the reasons stated in the application the same is allowed and the requirement of filing the certified copy of First Information (FIR) bearing no. 75/2026 dated 30.04.2026 is dispensed with for the time being. The applicants/petitioners shall file the same within two weeks. CrIM **disposed of.**

CRM(M)/290/2026

It is submitted by counsel for the petitioners that there is a matrimonial discard between the parties, whereas the respondent-wife has lodged a false and frivolous FIR which on the face of it does not disclose the commission of cognizable offence and the police agency has in violation of law got registered an FIR with a only view to subject to the petitioner to harassment and indecent prosecution.

Given the averments made, a prima facie case for consideration is made out.

In the meanwhile, subject to objections from the other side and till next date of hearing before the Bench, investigation in the FIR No. 75/2026 dated 30.04.2026 is stayed.
