The record reveals that there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner for the last five consecutive hearings (two before the Court and three before the Registrar Judicial).

Mr. A.R. Malik, the learned Senior Additional Advocate General submits that the learned counsel for the petitioner is avoiding to argue the matter in the light of the fact that the interim direction has been passed by this Court, which is harshly working against the interests of the respondents.
