CrIM No. 845/2026:

For the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed and the requirement of filing certified copy of FIR No. 107/2026 is dispensed with. The petitioners shall file the same within one week.

CrIM disposed of.

CRM (M) No. 366/2026:

The petitioners have challenged FIR No. 107/2026 for offences under Sections 9 and 11 of Prohibition of Child Marriage Act, 2006.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that petitioner No. 1 happens to be mother of the main accused, petitioner No. 2 happens to be his brother and petitioner No. 3 happens to be his sister-in-law. It has been contended that the petitioners have nothing to do with the solemnization of marriage of the minor child with the main accused.

Issue notice to the respondents.

Notice be sent to respondent No. 1 and 2 through Mr. Faheem Nisar Shah, learned GA. Notice be sent to respondent No. 3 and 4 through concerned Police Station.

In the meantime, the investigation in the impugned FIR may go ahead, however, in case challan is proposed to be filed against the petitioners, the same shall not be done without prior permission of this Court.
