ORDER
27.07.2026

1. Mr. Mohsin Qadri, learned Sr. AAG apprises this Court that the District Police, Srinagar has vacated the premises in reference and with respect to the assessment of the rental liability for the period of occupation, the same has also been worked out.
2. If the petitioner would not feel satisfied with quantification of the rental liability, then the petitioner is well within his right to work out his legal remedy.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it is a fact that the house premises of the petitioner

has been vacated by the District Police, Srinagar which otherwise was using the accommodation for the purpose of Police Post, Tengpora.

4. Now with respect to the assessment of the rental liability, in case the petitioner would reckon that the same is not as per the rent rate which is meant to be assessed as per the District Rent Assessment Committee, then the petitioner shall be well within his right to resort to his legal remedies accordingly without prejudice to the closure of this contempt petition.

5. **Contempt petition CCP (S) No. 205/2026** is closed.
