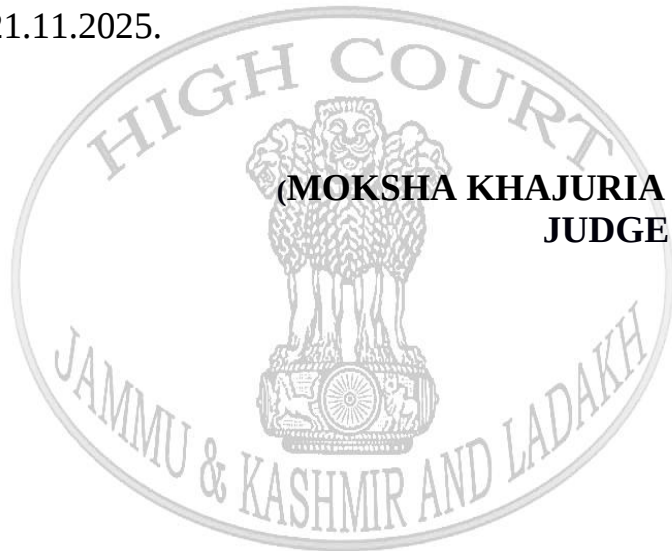
1. By this petition, petitioner has alleged non-compliance of the order passed by this Court, dated 22.12.2022, in case titled 'Mohammad Urfan Shah vs. State of J&K and Anr'. The relevant paragraph of the judgment is taken note of hereinbelow:

"Having regard to the submissions made by learned counsel appearing for the respondents and the stand taken by them that the case of the petitioner is under active consideration, therefore, no purpose can be achieved by keeping this petition pending, as such, the same is disposed of with a direction to respondents to consider and decide the case of petitioner for regularization in accordance with law within a period of three months from today, providing adequate opportunity of hearing to the petitioner."

2. Statement of facts stands filed by the respondents. It is stated that the matter for finalization of recruitment rules are under active consideration with the Administrative Department. Vide communication dated 19.11.2024, addressed to Vice Chairman J&K Lake Conservation and Management Authority Srinagar, the Administrative Department intimated that the recruitment rules are already finalized but awaiting approval of reorganization proposal from Finance Department.

3. On 22.12.2022, the Writ Petition bearing SWP No. 1012/2012, was disposed of on the basis of the fact that the case of the petitioner was under active consideration and as such, respondents were directed to accord consideration and decide the case of the petitioner for regularization in accordance with law. However, order passed by this Court dated 22.12.2022, has not been complied with till date.
4. Last and final opportunity is granted to the respondents, more particularly to Respondent No. 1, to comply with the order passed by this court on 22.12.2022, failing which, coercive measures shall be initiated against the officers responsible for non-compliance of the orders passed by this court.
