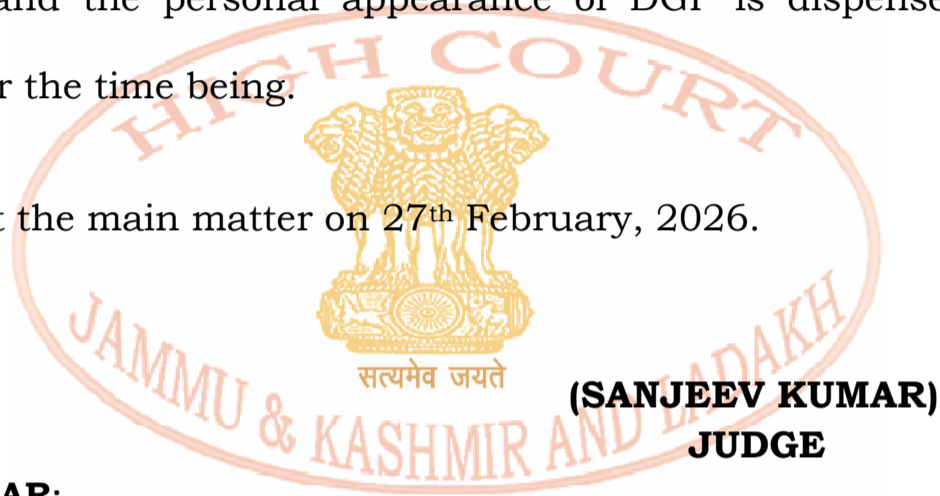

The statement of facts filed by the respondents indicates that some effort has been made by the Department of Police by entering into correspondence with the Department of Home for making budgetary allocation to meet the expenses of implementation of the judgment. Although this Court is not convinced with the explanation tendered which is nothing but an *ipse dixit* of the respondent, yet in the interest of justice and on the request made by Mr. Faheem Nisar Shah, learned GA, last and final opportunity of six weeks to come up with

the compliance is granted, failing which the DGP and Secretary to Government, Department of Home shall appear through virtual mode.
