ORDER

13.10.2025

1. The petitioners herein, having suffered loss of their Kothars in a fire blaze, were constrained to petition this Court with writ petition **WP(C) No. 859/2025** bearing grievance that their cases for compensation for the loss suffered were not being considered at the end of the writ respondents.

2. Keeping in view the nature of the issue raised in the said writ petition, the writ Court, by virtue of an order dated **01.07.2024**, without undertaking any adjudication on merits of the case, came to be dispose of the writ petition with a direction to the writ respondents to accord consideration to the case of the

petitioners on its own merits and strictly in accordance with the rules governing the field.

3. Needful was to be done within a period of six weeks from the date a copy of order dated **01.07.2024** passed by the writ Court was served upon the respondents.

4. The disposal of the writ petition had taken place in presence of Mr. Syed Musaib, learned Dy. AG representing the respondents.

5. The needful on behalf of the respondents having not been done till date has constrained the petitioners to come up with the present contempt petition.

6. Issue notice to the respondents/contemnors.

7. Petitioners to furnish registered postal covers, whereupon the notices to go to the respondents.

8. List again on **15.12.2025**.
