ORDER

The record reveals that the notice was issued in the instant matter wayback on 23rd of December, 2022 and the petitioner was directed to take steps for service upon the private respondents within one week. However, no such steps were taken for more than three years. Consequently, this Court vide order dated 2nd of June, 2025 granted further period of two weeks to take steps for service upon private respondent Nos. 8 to 16.

Despite the lapse of more than three years and the grant of repeated opportunities, steps for service upon the private respondents have still not been taken.

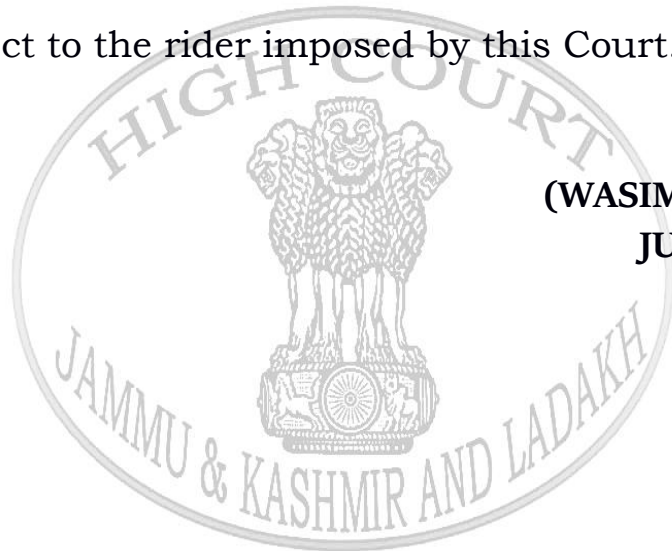
In the interest of justice, one week's further time is granted to the learned counsel for the petitioner to take steps for service upon the private respondent Nos. 8 to 16.

It is made clear that in case the requisite steps are not taken within the extended period of one week, the interim direction passed by this Court dated 23rd of December, 2022 shall not be extended.

In the meantime, interim direction(s), if any, subsisting as on date, shall continue till the next date of hearing before the Bench subject to the rider imposed by this Court.
