01. Petitioner, who is husband of respondent no. 2, is aggrieved of FIR no. 250/2025, primarily on the ground that they have lodged cross FIRs against each other and a matrimonial dispute is sought to be given a criminal colour, which is not countenanced in law.
02. *Prima facie* case for indulgence is made out.
03. Notice.
04. Mr. Zulkernain Sheikh, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of private respondent no. 2. He seeks and is granted four weeks' time to file objections.
05. Notice shall go to the respondent no. 1, returnable within four weeks. Requisite steps for service be taken within one week.
06. List on **27.02.2026**.
07. Meanwhile, impugned FIR shall stay.
