ORDER

With the consent of learned counsel for the parties, the petition is disposed of at this stage. The writ petition has been preferred against the order dated 06.01.2021 passed by respondent No. 1 whereby the revision petition filed by the petitioner has been disposed of with the observations as mentioned in it.

Objections to the petition stands filed by the private respondents.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, the Court is of the view that the order impugned requires modification in view of the observations made therein.

Accordingly, the petition is disposed of with a direction that the impugned order dated 06.01.2021 stands modified to the extent that the revenue authorities are directed to proceed regarding the partition between the parties as per law. The opportunity of being heard shall be given to the parties by the



Tehsildar. The petitioner herein will be at liberty to agitate the validity of partition proceedings before the said authority. The parties are directed to maintain status quo on spot till the matter is decided by the concerned authority.
