ORDER

In terms of order dated 28.04.2022, the respondent No. 5-Deputy Commissioner, Ramban had filed a compliance report stating therein that out of the 1 Kanal of land, 9 marlas has come under the alignment of road constructed from Batote to Boonbari and remaining 11 marlas is in continuous possession of the Forest Department on which their Sale Depot is in existence and the aforesaid 1 Kanal of land is proprietary land of the petitioner, now his grandson Suhail Gupta.

Since, 9 marlas of land was in alignment of the road which has been constructed by the PWD (R&B) Department, this Court, accordingly, impleaded Secretary, PWD (R&B) Department as respondent No. 7 in terms of the said order and he was directed to file counter affidavit to the petition within a period of one month.

Today, Mr. Ravinder Gupta, learned AAG appearing for the newly added respondent No. 7 seeks some more time to enable him to file the counter affidavit in terms of order dated 28.04.2022.

His submission is allowed. He may do the needful by or before the next date of hearing.
