The matter earlier was referred for mediation, however, for logistic reasons, the same could not be settled by way of mediation.

Given the nature of controversy involved, as the same has arisen out of violation under Section 138 of Negotiable Instrument Act, which is made compoundable at the appellate stage as well, the chance of matter being settled by way of mediation cannot be ruled out.

Accordingly, the matter is directed to be referred to the Coordinator, Main Mediation Centre, High Court of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh, where the parties shall appear on **12.03.2026**. The Coordinator shall ensure that before proceeding with the process of mediation parties are notified.
