**ORDER**  
**09.02.2026**

- 01.** Petitioners are aggrieved of FIR No. 0232/2025, registered with Police Station, Akhnoor, primarily on the ground that it is a counter blast to an FIR lodged by their father against the private respondents and their family.
- 02.** *Prima facie*, case for indulgence is made out.
- 03.** Notice.
- 04.** Ms. Shazia Asaf, Advocate appearing vice Mr. P. D. Singh, learned Dy. AG waives notice on behalf of official respondents. She seeks and is granted four weeks' time to file reply.
- 05.** Issue notice to the private respondents, returnable within three weeks. Requisite steps for service be taken within one week.
- 06.** List on **08.04.2026**.
- 07.** Meanwhile, investigating agency shall be at liberty to proceed with investigation of impugned FIR, however, presentation of charge sheet shall await orders of this Court.

08. In view of the allegations and counter allegations made by the parties against each other and cross FIRs, SSP, Jammu, is directed to assign investigation of both the FIRs to same investigating officer.
