**ORDER**

**11.02.2025**

In the instant petition, the petitioner herein is seeking quashment of order dated 20.11.2024, passed by the 1<sup>st</sup> Additional District Judge, Jammu in civil appeal No.82/2020, whereby respondent No.1 has been allowed to file petition/application afresh before the Deputy Labour Commissioner, Jammu against the petitioner.

It is stated by the learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner that the application filed by the respondents was withdrawn without seeking any liberty. However, subsequently, the respondents have filed a fresh application on the same ground and facts, which has been dismissed by the Deputy Labour Commissioner, Jammu (Authority under Payment of Wages Act). The respondents preferred an appeal bearing Civil Appeal No.82/2020 before the 1<sup>st</sup> Additional District Judge, Jammu, who has granted liberty to the respondents to file fresh application before the Deputy Labour Commissioner, Jammu (Authority under the Payment of Wages Act).

Issue notice to the respondent returnable within four weeks.

Requisites for service within one week.

Meanwhile, Registry is directed to requisition the relevant record from both from 1<sup>st</sup> Additional District Judge, Jammu of Civil Appeal No.82/2020 and from Deputy Commissioner, Jammu (Authority under the Payment of Wages Act) in the digitize form.
