ORDER

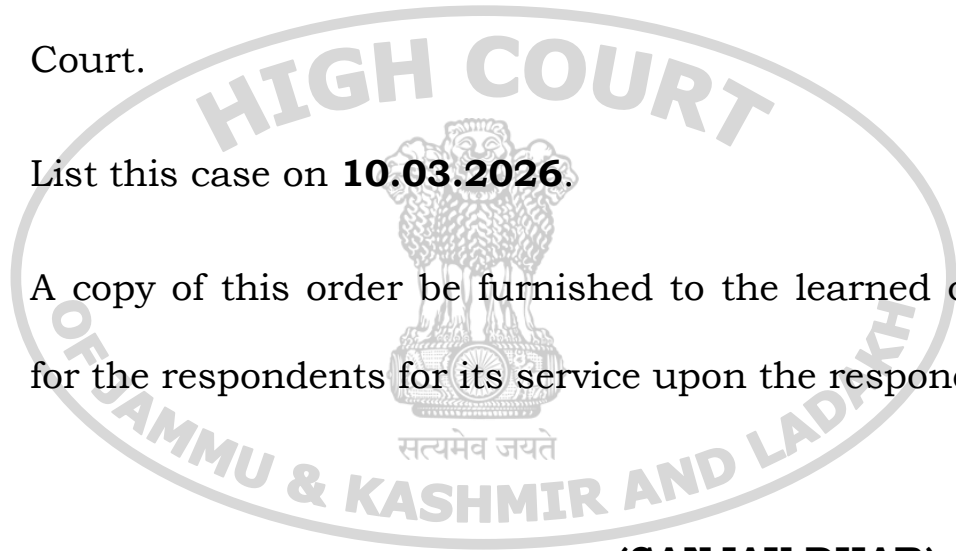

- 01.** As per the fresh statement of facts filed by the respondents, the judgment of the writ Court could not be implemented in its letter and spirit because the information sought from the petitioner with regard to examination centres in which the petitioner has appeared has not been provided by him. According to the respondents, the said information is relevant for examining the case of the petitioner in view of the **Government Order No. 252-HE of 2012 dated 30.05.2012.**
- 02.** So far as the information of the examination centres in which the petitioner has appeared in the examination in

connection with obtaining of relevant degree from Vinayak Mission's Research Foundation through distance mode is concerned, the said information may not be relevant for the purposes of the present case because as per Government Order dated 30.05.2012 (supra), degrees obtained through distance mode from campuses which have been established by the said University beyond its territorial jurisdiction are not recognized. The said Government Order does not indicate anything as regards the location of the examination centres. In any case, the petitioner claims that he has obtained the degree through distance mode, as such, there is no question of his attending any campus of the concerned University. The Government order on which the respondents have relied upon is not attracted to his case.

- 03.** Even otherwise, the concerned institution i.e. Vinayak Mission's Research Foundation has vide its communication dated 17.12.2024, made it clear that because the record is more than ten years old, the same is not available. It has also been confirmed that the University has issued genuine certificates, including bonafide certificate, mark sheet, degree certificate in favour of the petitioner.

- 04.** In the face of the aforesaid situation, the respondents have no other option but to implement the judgment of the writ Court and they cannot avoid the same by taking unnecessary and frivolous pleas day in and day out.
- 05.** Accordingly, the respondents are directed to come up with compliance report strictly in tune with the judgment of the writ Court on next date of hearing, failing which, an inference shall be drawn that they are willfully avoiding the implementation of the judgment of the writ Court.
- 06.** List this case on **10.03.2026**.
- 07.** A copy of this order be furnished to the learned counsel for the respondents for its service upon the respondents.
