ORDER
(18.07.2024)

1. Given the nature of the issue involved in this appeal with respect to the time of accident vis-à-vis the time of issuance of insurance policy by the appellant in favour of the respondent No. 2-Parvesh Gupta, the registered owner of the offending Load Carrier No. JKR/9852, this Court is constrained to direct fresh service of the respondent No. 2-Parvesh Gupta keeping in view the fact that Mr. Inderjeet Abrol, Advocate who had caused appearance on behalf of the respondent No. 2-Parvesh Gupta has come to state that for the last more than ten years he is not in contact with his client said Parvesh Gupta as is born out from the office noting dated 05.02.2024.

2. Accordingly, this Court directs service of the respondent No. 2-Parvesh Gupta through Tamilat Section of the Court of Principal District Judge, Jammu.

3. Registrar Judicial, Jammu to issue notice to the respondent No. 2 to be served through Tamilat Section of the Court of Principal District Judge, Jammu.



4. The appellant to procure summons from the Registrar Judicial, Jammu and deliver it to the Tamilat Section of the Court of Principal District Judge, Jammu wherefrom a process server to be deputed for effecting service of the respondent No. 2 in terms of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 and return the process.
