**ORDER**

12.02.2026

1. This Court, vide order dated 18.09.2025, had already observed that the matter was being unnecessarily dragged at the instance of learned counsel for the petitioner and, though reluctantly, adjourned the same with a clear rider that no further adjournment shall be granted on any count whatsoever, as the instant writ petition has been pending before this Court since the year 2020. Thereafter, the matter was listed on 04.12.2025, on which date an adjournment motion was moved by Mr. M. P. Gupta, learned counsel appearing for the respondents, seeking adjournment, and the matter was accordingly adjourned.
2. Today, when the matter was taken up, a request for adjournment has again been made by Mr. Anirudh Sharma, appearing vice Mr. Rahul Pant, learned Senior Advocate, on the ground that the learned Senior arguing counsel is not available today. Ordinarily,

this Court would not have adjourned the matter in view of the earlier order, however, Mr. Anirudh Sharma has assured the Court that on the next date of hearing he shall argue the matter even if his learned Senior does not appear.

3. In light of the aforesaid assurance, the matter is adjourned with a clear rider that in case none appears on behalf of the petitioner on the next date of hearing, appropriate orders shall follow and the interim directions shall not be extended in that eventuality.
4. List again on 26.02.2026, higher up in the cause list.
