- 01.** Petitioner has invoked inherent jurisdiction of this Court for the quashment of FIR No.0039/2024 along with consequential proceedings arising therefrom including the challan presented in the Court of learned Munsiff (JMIC), R.S.Pura, primarily on the ground that contents of the FIR, even if taken at their face value would not disclose the commission of any offence against the petitioner as the allegations are omnibus in nature and no specific role has been attributed to him.
- 02.** *Prima facie*, case for indulgence is made out.
- 03.** Issue notice to the respondents, returnable within four weeks. Requisites for service within one week.
- 04.** Send for the scanned record of the trial Court.
- 05.** List on 06.05.2026.
- 06.** Meanwhile, proceedings before the trial Court qua the petitioner shall stay.
