ORDER

WP(C) No. 857/2022

The petitioners in this case have *inter alia* challenged the tentative award dated 08.02.2013 bearing No. ACQ/Gen/1133 passed by the respondent No. 3-Collector Land Acquisition, Railway Ramban, District Ramban.

A perusal of the writ petition reveals that the petitioners have not mentioned the details of their land, which is subject matter of the impugned award. Therefore, they are directed to furnish the particulars of the land owned/possessed by them, which is subject matter of the impugned award by filing an additional affidavit to this effect.

Needful be done by next date of hearing.

The respondents shall produce the entire record relating to the acquisition, which is subject matter of the impugned award on the next date of hearing.

The instant writ petition be delinked and listed separately on 03.04.2024.

WP(C) No. 271/2022

The petitioner, through the medium of instant writ petition, has challenged Notification dated 27.10.2016 issued under Section 4, Sub Section 1 of the J&K Land Acquisition Act, 1990 by respondent No. 2/Collector Land Acquisition (SDM) Gool as also the subsequent notifications. In the petition, it has been claimed that the petitioner is owner of the property and residential house comprised in khasra No. 293 measuring 07 kanals and 10 marlas situated at Village, Gool, District Ramban. According to the petitioner, his land figuring at serial No. 41 of the impugned notification, has been identified for acquisition.

A perusal of the impugned notification shows that neither khasra No. 293 min figures in the said notification nor item No. 41 figures in the said notification. In fact impugned notification related to only 39 items.

The petitioner is, therefore, directed to file an additional affidavit explaining the aforesaid aspect of the matter before the next date of hearing. The respondents shall produce the entire record in respect of the impugned notification on the next date of hearing.

The instant writ petition be delinked and listed separately on 03.04.2024.

WP(C) No. 2819/2021

Through the medium of present petition, the petitioners have challenged award bearing No. ACQ/Gen/10988 dated 08.01.2023 and the order issued by respondent No. 4-Collector Land Acquisition, Ramban. In the writ petition, the petitioners have not given the particulars of the land, which is subject matter of the impugned award.

The petitioners are directed to specify the particulars of the land, which is subject matter of the impugned award. In this regard, they shall file an additional affidavit. Needful be done by next date of hearing.

The respondents shall produce the entire record relating to the acquisition, which is subject matter of the impugned award, on the next date of hearing.

The instant writ petition be delinked and listed separately on 03.04.2024.

WP(C) No. 2856/2022

Through the medium of present writ petition, the petitioner has challenged show cause notice bearing No. ACDJ/P&S/ 2022-23/8329-35 dated 22.10.2022 and order bearing No. RDD-NREGA/190/2022-02 dated 24.11.2022 issued by respondent No. 1 recommending the termination of the petitioner.

The instant writ petition be delinked from other petitions and listed separately on 01.04.2024.

Meanwhile, respondents shall file objections.

WP(C) No. 2206/2022

The petitioners, through the medium of instant writ petition, have challenged final award bearing No. 338-43/ADC/ACQ dated 22.02.2022 passed

by respondent No. 4-Collector Land Acquisition (SDM), Gool, District Ramban. The petitioners have not furnished the particulars and the specifications of the properties that are subject matter of the impugned award.

Therefore, the petitioners are directed to furnish the relevant details of the properties owned/possessed by them by filing an additional affidavit to this effect.

The respondents shall produce the entire record relating to the acquisition, which is subject matter of the impugned award, on the next date of hearing.

The instant writ petition be delinked and listed separately on 03.04.2024.

WP(C) No. 2817/2021

The petitioners, through the medium of instant writ petition, have challenged *inter alia* notification bearing No. 94-100/SDM/G/Gref dated 27.10.2016 passed by respondent No. 3-Collector Land Acquisition, Gool. In the petition, the petitioners have not furnished the details of the land owned/possessed by them, which is subject matter of the impugned notification.

Therefore, the petitioners are directed to file an additional affidavit indicating therein the particulars of the land/property owned/possessed by them, which is subject matter of the impugned notification by next date of hearing.

The respondents shall produce the entire record relating to the acquisition, which is subject matter of the impugned notification, on the next date of hearing.

The instant writ petition be delinked and listed separately on 03.04.2024.

WP(C) No. 2818/2021

The petitioners, through the medium of instant writ petition, have challenged *inter alia* notification bearing No. 94-100/SDM/G/Gref dated 27.10.2016 passed by respondent No. 3-Collector Land Acquisition, Gool. In the petition, the petitioners have not furnished the details of the land owned/possessed by them, which is subject matter of the impugned notification.

Therefore, the petitioners are directed to file an additional affidavit indicating therein the particulars of the land/property owned/possessed by them, which is subject matter of the impugned notification by next date of hearing.

The respondents shall produce the entire record relating to the acquisition, which is subject matter of the impugned notification, on the next date of hearing.

The instant writ petition be delinked and to be listed along with WP(C) No. 2817/2021 on 03.04.2024.
