ORDER

17.07.2025

1. The instant four Civil Miscellaneous Appeals, filed under the provisions of Section 173 of Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 along with cross objections, arise out of a common award dated 08.02.2017 passed by learned Motor Accident Claims (MAC) Tribunal, Jammu on four claim petitions bearing Nos. 408, 409 and 410 dated 13.09.2014 and 616 dated 14.01.2015.
2. Since the issue involved in these appeals as well as in the cross objections is as regards the quantum of compensation, as such, there appear to be elements of settlement in the case.
3. National Legal Services Authority (NALSA) has initiated a special drive for amicable settlement of the cases through the mode of mediation under the campaign, "***Mediation For The Nation***". As such, the instant matter is referred for its amicable settlement through mediation to the Coordinator Mediation Center, High Court of J&K

and Ladakh, Jammu for taking necessary steps in the matter towards its expected amicable settlement through mediation.

4. Learned counsel for the parties are requested to be informed about the date of mediation of this case in connection whereof a special cause list is likely to be published, in due course of time. The parties to this petition or their authorized representatives shall appear in person before the learned Mediator to be appointed for this case on due date.
