ORDER

1. The petitioners, through the instant petition, seek quashment of FIR No. 0052/2026 dated 04.04.2026 registered at Police Station Mendhar under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 351(2) and 352 of BNS.
2. The petitioners' contention is that the FIR is arising out of a civil dispute relating to land but the complainant has given it a criminal flavour just to wreak the vengeance.
3. Issue notice in the main as well as in the connected application.
4. Notice is waived by Ms. Nisha Kangotra, Advocate appearing vice Mr. Eishaan Dadhichi, learned Government Advocate for respondent No. 1. Let the response be filed by the next date of hearing.
5. Notice shall now go to respondent No 2, subject to furnishing of requisites by the petitioners within one week. '*Dasti*' service is also permitted.
6. List on **03.07.2026**.

7. Meanwhile, subject to objections from the other side and till next date of hearing, the investigation in the impugned FIR shall continue, however, the final report shall not be filed without prior permission of this Court.
