ORDER (ORAL)**

1. By this petition, petitioner herein is seeking a direction upon respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to forthwith take cognizance of the illegal retention and unauthorized use of vehicle No. JKI2C- 8883, enforce the provisions of Sections 50 and 51 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 and also seeking a direction upon respondent No. 4 to either clear the outstanding bank liability and complete the transfer of ownership or to surrender the vehicle.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner would feel satisfied, if this petition is disposed of, at this stage with a direction to



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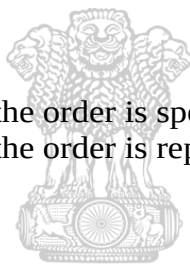
respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to consider the representation of the petitioner filed on 26.03.2026.
