ORDER
(26.07.2024)

- 01.** When this case was called in the morning, Mr. Pawan Dev Singh, learned Dy. AG was asked by this Court to fetch the status of the investigation with respect to an FIR No. 0031/2020 with the Police Station Nagrota for whose quashment the present petition came to be filed by the petitioner.
- 02.** Mr. Pawan Dev Singh, learned Dy. AG sought time post break for getting the Investigating Officer (I.O.) concerned along the status report in compliance to the direction dated 10.05.2024 which required the Case Diaries to be produced.
- 03.** Mr. Akash Kohli, SDPO Nagrota who is the Investigating Officer (I.O.) is present in person along the Case Diaries.

- 04.** Mr. Pawan Dev Singh, learned Dy. AG submits that the investigation in the FIR in reference is complete and final report and the investigation's outcome is likely to be presented very shortly after the requisite sanctions applied for come to be on record of the file as the finishing aspect of the investigation.
- 05.** In this case, there has been no intervening direction with respect to stay of investigation or with respect to presentation of challan and, therefore, by the statement so made by Mr. Aakash Kohli, SDPO Nagrota, this petition *prima facie* seems to have rendered itself infructuous. However, at this moment, Mr. M. L. Gupta, learned counsel for the petitioner is not present, as such, an appropriate order would be passed upon his appearance on next date.
- 06.** Mr. Aakash Kohli, SDPO Nagrota who is present in person along with Case Diaries is, therefore, relieved from his appearance.
