Through the medium of this petition, petitioner herein has challenged order dated 07.05.2026, passed by Respondent No. 2 in appeal titled “*Mohan Lal Vs. Harvinder Sharma & Ors.*” bearing File No. RD0050000035289, whereby the appeal filed by the petitioner, against the order dated 27.09.2022 passed by Respondent No. 3 on Mutation No. 121, has been dismissed.
