ORDER

1. By this petition, filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners seek a direction upon the official respondents not to evict them from their respective houses/property unless and until the fair procedure is adopted by the official respondents under Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 (*hereinafter referred to as, "the Act of 2013"*), with a further direction to the official respondents to assess and determine the compensation with respect to the claim of the petitioners strictly in accordance with the provisions of the Act of 2013.
2. Notice.
3. Ms. Chetna Manhas, Assisting counsel to Ms. Monika Kohli, Sr. AAG waives notice on behalf of respondent Nos. 1, 3 & 4 and Ms. Mehar Bali, Assisting counsel to Mr. Ravinder Gupta, AAG on behalf of respondent Nos. 2, 6 & 7. They seek and are granted four weeks' time for filing reply, with an advance copy to learned counsel for the petitioners.

4. Let notice be issued to respondent No. 5, returnable within four weeks.
5. Learned counsel for the petitioners is directed to furnish copy of the petition to learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent Nos. 2, 6 & 7 during the course of this week.
6. List again on **20.07.2026**.
7. Meanwhile, respondents are directed not to dispossess the petitioners from their respective houses without adopting due process of law.
