- 01.** Petitioner has invoked inherent jurisdiction of this Court for the quashment of order dated 30.04.2026, passed by learned Sub-Judge/ Special Railway Magistrate, Jammu [“the trial Court”] under Section 175(3) BNSS, primarily on the ground that it came to be passed on a complaint preferred by respondent No. 2 by concealment and suppression of material facts. It is contention of the petitioner that learned trial Court has ignored the detailed report submitted by the prosecution, indicating that no offence was made out against him.
- 02.** *Prima facie*, case for indulgence is made out.
- 03.** Issue notice to the respondents, returnable within four weeks. Requisite steps for service be taken within one week.
- 04.** List on **21.08.2026**.
- 05.** Meanwhile, impugned order shall stay.
