01. Petitioner has invoked inherent jurisdiction of this Court for the quashment of order dated 17.11.2025 passed by learned Munsiff, Akhnoor [“the trial court”] in a complaint preferred by the respondent under the provisions of Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 and petition for maintenance preferred by the respondent under Section 144 BNSS before learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Jammu [“the trial court”], primarily on the ground that respondent is guilty of suppression of material facts from the Courts below, as she had already executed a divorce agreement dated 12.03.2024 with the petitioner by mutual consent, which was duly notarised.

02. *Prima facie*, case for indulgence is made out.

03. Notice to the respondent, returnable within four weeks. Requisite steps for service be taken within one week.

04. List on 08.07.2026.

05. Meanwhile, proceedings pending before both the trials court, i.e., Munsiff Akhnoor and Principal Judge, Family Court, Jammu shall stay.
