01. Vide order dated 26.02.2026, one, Rajesh Sharma, intervener in this petition submitted that his electricity connection had been disconnected on the recommendation of the Commissioner-cum-receiver, by the Electric Department and that he and his family had been suffering on that count. He was directed to approach to the Commissioner-cum-receiver so that his request could be considered.
02. The said intervener has filed an application bearing **CM No. 4397/2026** seeking clarification/modification of the order dated 24.11.2025. Mr. R.K. Jain, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioners, apprises this Court that, since a Receiver has been appointed to manage the property, he is required to put on notice with regard to the aforesaid application.
03. Issue notice to the Receiver.
04. Mr. J.A. Hamal, Advocate waives notice on behalf of the Receiver.
05. Copy of the aforesaid application be furnished to counsel appearing for the Receiver, who shall file a response by or before the next date of hearing.

06. Having regard to the controversy involved and keeping in view that order dated 24.11.2025 is sought to be clarified/modified, list this application (CM No. 4397/2026) before the same Bench that has passed the order dated 24.11.2025, after obtaining instructions from the Hon'ble the Chief Justice.
07. List this matter on **20.08.2026**.
