6. Meanwhile, subject to objections and till next date before the Bench, status quo, as on date, with regard to the possession of the house and shops raised over the land falling under Khasra No. 183-min measuring 05 Marlas situated at village Thanna, Tehsil Thannamandi

District Rajouri, shall be maintained. Alteration/modification on laying motion.
