ORDER

14.07.2026

01. Petitioner has thrown challenge to the order of Joint Financial Commissioner Revenue (with power of Commissioner, Agrarian Reforms), Jammu, impugned herein, in terms whereof, the revision against the order of Additional Deputy Commissioner, Poonch has been accepted and order passed by said authority has been set aside. It is submitted that the order of Joint Financial Commissioner Revenue suffers from the legal errors, thus, the petitioner has no other remedy but to invoke the writ jurisdiction of this Court. Since with the amendment made in the Agrarian Reforms Act, the power of revision given to the Tribunal has been taken away.
02. *Prima facie*, a case for intervention is made out.
03. Heard.
04. Issue notice to the respondents.
05. Ms. Nisha Kangotra, Advocate appearing vice Mrs. Monika Kohli, learned Sr. AAG, waives notice on behalf of respondent No. 1 to 3.

06. Notice shall go to respondent No. 4 in the first instance, returnable within four weeks, subject to the taking of requisite steps within one week.
07. List on **02.09.2026**.
08. Meanwhile, subject to objections and till the next date of hearing before the Bench, parties are directed to maintain status quo as regards the effect and operation of order impugned.
