**ORDER
(17.07.2026)**

1. The petitioners, through the medium of present petition, seek quashing of FIR No. 57/2026 dated 20.05.2026 registered at Police Station Kandi, Rajouri for commission of offences punishable under Sections 316(2), 316(5), 318(1), 318(4), 322, 324(4), 336(2), 336(3) & 340(2) of the BNS, 2023 against them at the instance of respondent No. 2-Vidya Devi.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that respondent No. 2 has raised an issue with regard to entitlement to the claim of the pensionary benefits of Ex-Serviceman-Sunder Singh with her mother-Shanti Devi who happens to be the mother of petitioner No. 1 and grandmother of petitioner No. 2 and has falsely implicated the petitioners in the above case, though at the time of filing the details by said Shanti Devi, she had disclosed the particulars of respondent No. 2-Vidya Devi also, as the daughter of the deceased.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that it is essentially a civil dispute between the mother of petitioner No. 1 and grandmother of petitioner No. 2 and respondent No. 2, who happens to be her daughter and that there was no

criminality involved in this case, as such, registration of the case is misuse of the process.

4. Heard.

5. Notice to the respondents, returnable within four weeks. Requisites for service within one week.

6. List on **19.08.2026**.

7. Meanwhile, subject to objections from the other side and till next date of hearing, investigation in the impugned FIR No. 57/2026 dated 20.05.2026 registered at Police Station Kandi, Rajouri shall stay.
