ORDER
30.01.2026

1. The applicant/petitioner has filed the instant application, which has been registered as CM No. 251/2026, seeking a direction to respondent No. 4 to declare the result of 2nd Professional examination of MBBS course 2023-24 Batch and also to permit him to appear in the supplementary examination of 2nd Prof. MBBS Course of 2023-24 Batch and future professional examinations.
2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has drawn the attention of this Court to the order passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court on 12.08.2025, wherein a direction was issued to respondent No. 4-University of Jammu, through its Vice Chancellor/Registrar, and respondent No. 5-Acharya Shri Chander College of Medical Sciences and Hospital, Sidhra, Jammu, to allow the petitioner to take his 2nd Prof. Examination provisionally at his

own risk and cost, with the rider that the result of the petitioner shall not be declared without the permission of this Court.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has appeared in the examination pursuant to the directions passed by this Court, therefore, it has become necessary to declare the result of the 2nd Prof. Examination, as only in case of his failure in examination, he would be required to appear in the supplementary examination scheduled to be held on 03.02.2026.
4. It is the specific case of the petitioner that he has appeared in the 2nd Prof. Examination held in August, 2025 and also in subsequent examinations pursuant to the directions issued by this Court from time to time, therefore, the University is under an obligation to declare the result of the petitioner so that he can avail the opportunity to appear in the supplementary examination to be held on 03.02.2026.
5. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that in case the result of the petitioner is not declared, grave prejudice shall be caused to the petitioner and the very purpose of filing of instant petition shall stand forfeited.
6. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner at length and perused the record.
7. *Prime facie*, this Court is in agreement with submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and, accordingly, a direction is issued to respondent No. 4-University of Jammu, to keep the result of the petitioner for 2nd Prof. Examination in a sealed cover and

produce the same before this Court tomorrow, so that appropriate directions may be passed in the instant application.

8. List this matter tomorrow, i.e. on 31.01.2026 in the supplementary list.
9. Registry is directed to convey this order to the Registrar, University of Jammu, for its immediate compliance.
10. Copy of this order be also provided to Mr. Rajnish Raina, learned Senior Counsel appearing for the respondent-University under the seal and signature of the Bench Secretary.
