- 01.** A writ petition **SWP No. 203/2007** was preferred by 528 petitioners with the petitioner No. 1 being the petitioner herein-Talib Hussain. Said writ petition came to be disposed of without adjudication on merits in terms of an order dated **02.04.2009** passed by this Court.
- 02.** Thereafter, the petitioner had come forward individually with a Writ Petition **SWP No. 3487/2014** which too came to be disposed of in the same fashion without adjudication on merits, in terms of an order dated **18.12.2014** in terms whereof the writ respondents were directed to consider the case of the petitioner for grant of higher pay scale in terms

of the applicable rules and pass consideration order within a period of four weeks from the date of service of a copy of the order dated **18.12.2014**.

03. It is by purported reference to the aforesaid two outcomes of the two writ petitions that the petitioner is coming forward with the present contempt petition which *ex-facie* seems to be time-barred afflicted with *delay and laches*.

04. Learned counsel for the petitioner is called upon to explain about the maintainability of the contempt petition on the next date of hearing.
