1. According to the appearing counsels for the parties, the instant petition has been wrongly clubbed with the listed matters and would pray for de-linking of the same.

2. Ordered accordingly. Registry is directed to list separately the instant petition on **21.02.2025**.

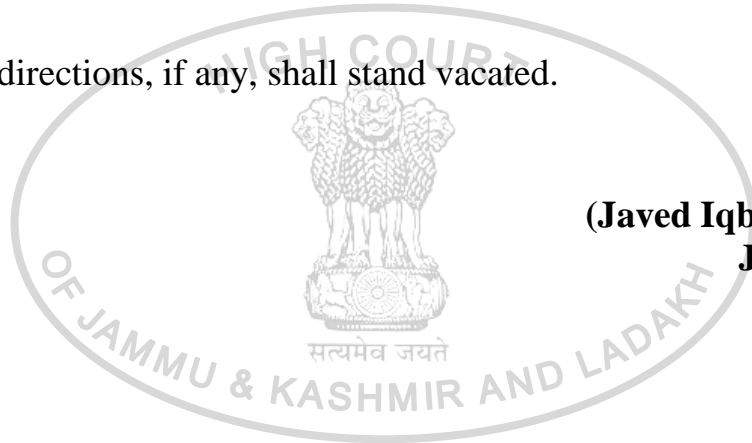

3. Upon coming of these instant petitions for consideration, it surfaced that the FIRs and the counter FIRs in the instant petitions have been got registered by the parties against each other in respect of immovable property consisting of 4 Kanal land falling under Survey No. 178 situated at Village Chack Jagar, Tehsil Marh, District Jammu. It also gets revealed from the record that in respect of the said immovable property, the parties are as well litigating before the civil court against each other.
4. Having regard to the respective pleadings of the parties as also the FIRs under challenge in the instant petitions, it is deemed appropriate to allow the Investigating Agency to investigate the said FIRs and complete the same within some time frame. The appearing counsels for the parties consented to the conduct of the investigation in the FIRs under challenge in the instant petitions instead of having the veracity of the FIRs determined and adjudicated upon by this Court in the instant petitions.
5. Mr. J. P. Gandhi, appearing counsel for the petitioners in CRMC No. 160/2015, CRMC No. 161/2015 and CRMC No. 528/2015 would however submit that in one of the FIRs under challenge in the instant petitions, the investigation has already been completed and the charge sheet has been filed before the competent court.
6. Be that as it may, in view of the aforesaid position obtaining in the matter inasmuch as having regard to the facts and circumstances of the cases, the SSP Jammu is directed to constitute a Special Investigation Team headed

by an officer not below the rank of Dy. SP for investigating the FIR Nos. 256/2014, 412/2014, 154/2015, 427/2013 and complaint dated 06.01.2015 challenged in the instant petitions except the FIR which is reported to have been investigated and the challan filed before the competent court and ensure completion of the investigation without any delay, preferably within a period of three months from the date copy of this order is produced by either of the parties before him.

7. The instant petitions accordingly shall stand disposed of making it clear that the investigation as directed above shall be conducted by the Investigating Agency fairly and transparently and un-influenced by any observation made hereinabove.
8. **Disposed of.**
9. Interim directions, if any, shall stand vacated.
