have been made in the FIR. The said petition was considered and vide order dated 20.09.2023, further investigation in the FIR has been stayed.

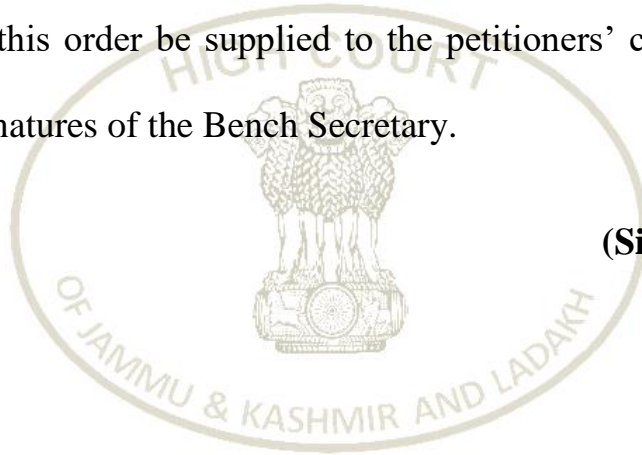
Notice to the respondents, returnable within four weeks.
