JUDGMENT (ORAL)**

- 01.** The institution of this writ petition came to take place on 09.02.2016 by the petitioner who at the relevant point of time was nineteen years of age coming forward claiming writ of mandamus unto the respondent No. 2-Chief of Army Staff, New Delhi and the respondent No. 3-Recruiting Officer (Dir Reg) to recruit the petitioner as Soldier GD.
- 02.** In his writ petition, the petitioner has come forth with the assertions that he had participated in a recruitment rally for trade soldier (General Duty) held by the respondent No. 3-Recruiting Officer (Dir Reg), Army Recruiting Office, B.C. Road, Jammu at Rajouri on 19.11.2014 relating to which the written examination result published on 05.03.2015 which showed the petitioner as successful.

03. The petitioner is even said to have been subjected to medical examination at Military Hospital 150 GH, Rajouri but without letting the petitioner know about the outcome of his medical examination.
04. The very fact that the petitioner claims to have reported himself for medical examination did not earn him any vested right for the petitioner to come and insist for his selection and appointment. In fact, the petitioner has not asked for the essential relief without asking which the relief as claimed in the petition is not conceivable and the said essential relief was the disclosure of final outcome of the recruitment exercise so undertaken by the respondent No. 3.
05. In the light of this inherent deficiency in the writ petition of the petitioner, the writ petition is held to be misconceived and is **dismissed**, accordingly.
06. The detailed order is following the order dated 16.02.2023 vide which the writ petition was ordered to be dismissed as is hereby being done.
