JUDGMENT (ORAL)

- 01.** The institution of this writ petition has taken place on 14.09.2017 by the petitioner with a purported grievance related to cancellation of **e-NIT No. 46 of 2017-18** with respect to which the petitioner reckoned himself to be the lowest bidder and hence entitled to earn allotment of the tendered work.
- 02.** Along with this writ petition, the petitioner had preferred an application **IA No. 1/2017** thereby seeking stay of **corrigendum No. 3627-30** dated **09.09.2017** and **e-NIT bearing No. 56 of 2017-18** issued by the respondent

No. 2-**Executive Engineer, PWD, (R&B), Division Samba, District Samba.**

03. In the writ petition, the **e-NIT No.** is **46** of **2017-18** and whereas in the application **IA No. 1/2017** the **e-NIT No.** is **56** of **2017-18**.
04. Reply to the writ petition came to be filed on **25.09.2017** by Mr. L.K. Moza, learned Advocate wherein he referred **e-NIT No. 46 of 2017-18** dated **01.08.2017** for the **construction of link road Central University Road, Suchani to Bua Dati Temple** with reasons from the end of the respondents for cancellation of the tendered work came to be set out in the reply.
05. It is important to bear in mind that at no point of time, this Court came to grant any interim indulgence except directing **status-quo** as on date with respect to tendering process to be maintained.
06. By the efflux of time lasting the pendency of writ petition, this Court sees no purpose in granting the writ-reliefs as claimed by the petitioner in the writ petition and accordingly, the writ petition is **dismissed** with liberty reserved in favour of the petitioner to participate in the fresh tendering process.
07. The writ petition is accordingly, **dismissed**.

08. The detailed order is following the order dated 06.04.2023 vide which the writ petition was ordered to be **dismissed** as is hereby being done.
