**ORDER**

A Coordinate Bench of this Court by virtue of order dated 16.04.2019 passed in CPSW No. 224/2016 issued a direction to the Finance Department to immediately make arrangements to transfer ₹ 25 crores to the JKKFED to enable it to discharge its liability towards the retiral dues and salaries of its employees, but nothing has been done till date.

Let an affidavit be filed by the Secretary Finance Department to show as to how the order has been complied with. Needless to say that the petitioner is also claiming his retiral benefits. The petitioner can get this benefit only if the said amount is ordered to be transferred in favour of the JAKFED.

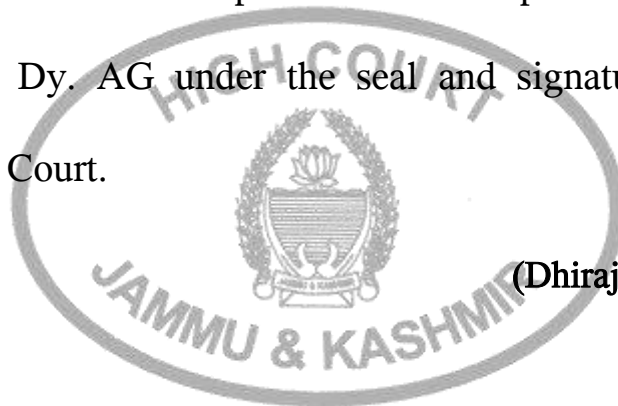
On asking of the petitioner, who is present in person, Mr. A. K. Mehta, Commissioner/Secretary to Government, Union Territory of J&K,
