By this petition, the petitioner herein is seeking a direction upon respondents not to allot the Station Ticket Booking Agent (STBA) for Railway station Khari to respondent no. 3 on being declared as successful with a further direction upon the respondents to issue fresh tender as has been done with respect to the other stations which are mentioned in the NIT.

Mr. Vishal Sharma, learned DSGI states that the application form of the petitioner is not accompanied with the demand draft of Rs. 2,000/-.

Issue notice to the respondents.

Mr. Eishaan Dadhichi, learned CGSC waives notice on behalf of respondent nos. 1 and 2. He seeks and is granted four weeks' time for filing reply with an advance copy to the counsel for the other side. Now notice shall go to respondent no. 3, returnable within four weeks, subject to taking of requisite steps for service within one week.

Meanwhile, allotment made to respondent no. 3 shall remain subject to outcome of the writ petition.
