ORDER
19.11.2025

01. By this petition, petitioner herein is seeking a direction upon the respondents to grant permission in his favour for acquisition of the machinery in terms of Rule 3, Schedule I, Column II of the Arms Rules, 2016, with a further direction upon the respondents to adjudicate upon the various applications filed by the petitioner seeking permission from the official respondents for acquisition of machinery in terms of Rule 3, Schedule I, Column II of the Arms Rules, 2016.

02. It is stated by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner-company is a registered company, and its registered office is situated in the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir. Petitioner-company has completed all the formalities, as stipulated in the procedure, and has time and again requested the official respondents to grant the petitioner-company permission for acquisition of a machinery. However, the official respondents, for the reasons best known to them, are reluctant to adjudicate upon the applications filed by the petitioner and have till date not taken any decision in respect of the same.

03. Mr. Sachin Gupta, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner-company would feel satisfied, if the instant petition is disposed of with direction to the respondents to consider various applications filed by the petitioner seeking permission with respect to acquisition of the machinery in terms of Rule 3, Schedule I, Column II of the Arms Rules, 2016.

04. Be that as it may, since the prayer of the petitioner is innocuous, this petition is disposed of, at the threshold, with a direction to the respondents to consider various applications filed by the petitioner-company strictly in accordance with rules and law applicable, provided there is no legal impediment therefor, within a period of two months from the date a certified copy of this order is served upon the respondents.
