Vide this petition, the petitioners had prayed for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent authorities for willful disobedience of the order and judgment dated 30-12-2015.

An analysis of the order and judgment referred to above shows that the petition was disposed of by the Writ Court with a direction to the respondent authorities to consider their claim for regularization strictly in accordance with the rules.

The compliance report dated 16-02-2017 filed on behalf of respondents shows that the authorities had considered the claim of the petitioners and vide SF Order No.272 of 2016 dated 15-11-2016 concluded that the petitioners were not entitled to regularization, for, they were engaged in a project for a specific purpose and for a specified time. And, on completion of the project, the petitioners were disengaged and, therefore, they were not entitled to regularization in terms of the rules.

That being so, nothing substantive survives in the petition and the same is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
