ORAL ORDER

On the allegation that respondent no.4 has put up construction in violation of building bye-laws and the sanctioned plan, petitioner has made a representation to respondent nos.1 to 3-Bruhat Bengaluru Mahanagara Palike (BBMP) now Greater Bengaluru Authority (GBA) to take action against respondent no.4. As the same has not been done, the present writ petition is filed with a prayer to direct the respondents-BBMP to consider the request of petitioner and take appropriate action against the construction put up by respondent no.4.

2. Learned counsel for respondent no.4 is absent.
3. Learned counsel for respondent nos.1 to 3-BBMP, now GBA upon instructions, submits that they will consider the request of petitioner and take appropriate action against the construction put up by respondent no.4. His submission is placed on record.
4. For the aforementioned reasons, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** with a direction to respondent nos.1 to 3 to



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initiate appropriate action against the construction put up by respondent no.4 in the manner known to law.

5. The entire exercise shall be completed within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
