THIS WP IS FILED UNDER ARTICLES 226 AND 227 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA PRAYING TO QUASH THE NOMINATION OF RESPONDENTS NOS.5 TO 9 TO THE ELECTIONS OF THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF 3RD RESPONDENT, DATED.31.10.2024 IN FORM-29 OF KARNATAKA WAKF RULES 2017, AND SUBSEQUENT PROCEEDINGS AS PER ANNEXURE-G AS ILLEGAL; DIRECT THE RESPONDENTS NOS. 02 AND 04 TO NOTIFYING THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD TO 3RD RESPONDENT AFRESH AND TO CONSTITUTE THE BOARD OF 3RD RESPONDENT STRICTLY IN COMPLIANCE OF PROVISION OF (WAKF ACT 1995 AND KARNATAKA WAKF RULES 2017); DIRECT THE 2ND RESPONDENT TO ENQUIRE IN TO THE PETITION DATED.08.11.2024, FILED BY THE PETITIONER U/S 16 OF THE WAKF ACT 1995 AS PER ANNEXURE-H, BEFORE ISSUING NOTIFICATION NOTIFYING THE RESPONDENT NOS.5 TO 9 AS THE MEMBERS OF NEW BOARD TO BE CONSTITUTED TO THE 3RD RESPONDENT.

ORAL ORDER
